✓ **Co-curricular Activities – “Students are introduced to a whole new horizon of activities that give them better insights and let them choose what they enjoy and wish to learn.”**

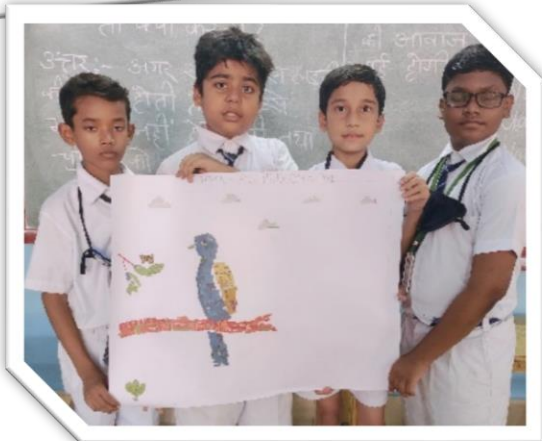

समय का महत्व

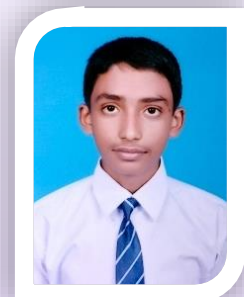
*काल करे सो आज कर, आज करे सो अब ।
