ऐसे ही एक नायक मेजर सोमनाथ शर्मा थे - परमवीर चक्र और देश का सर्वोच्च वीरता पुरस्कार प्राप्त करने वाले पहले व्यक्ति । मेजर जनरल अमरनाथ शर्मा के बेटे मेजर सोमनाथ शर्मा का जन्म 31 जनवरी 1923 को हिमाचल प्रदेश में हुआ था। वह प्रतिष्ठित सैन्य सेवा की एक स्थापित पृष्ठभूमि के साथ एक प्रसिद्ध परिवार से आए थे। उनके पिता, मेजर जनरल अमर नाथ शर्मा, निदेशक, चिकित्सा सेवा (सेना) के रूप में सेवानिवृत्त हुए । एक प्रतिष्ठित सैन्य पृष्ठभूमि वाले परिवार से आने के बाद, यह स्वाभाविक था कि शेरवुड कॉलेज में अपनी स्कूली शिक्षा पूरी करने के बाद, उन्हें देहरादून के प्रिंस ऑफ वेल्स रॉयल मिलिट्री कॉलेज में दाखिला लेने के लिए प्रेरित किया गया और फिर रॉयल मिलिट्री अकादमी में शामिल हो गए।

सफल स्नातक स्तर की पढ़ाई पर, उन्हें 22 फरवरी 1942 को भारतीय सेना (तत्कालीन ब्रिटिश भारतीय सेना) में 8 वीं बटालियन, 19 वीं हैदराबाद रेजिमेंट (बाद में 4 वीं बटालियन, कुमाऊं रेजिमेंट) में लेफ्टिनेंट के रूप में नियुक्त किया गया था। 22 अक्टूबर 1947 को पाकिस्तान ने जम्मू-कश्मीर पर कबायली आक्रमण किया। इरादा कश्मीर घाटी को बलपूर्वक हड़पना था। 26 अक्टूबर को जैसे ही राज्य संघ का हिस्सा बना, इसकी सुरक्षा भारत की जिम्मेदारी बन गई। बहादुरी से लड़ने के लिए उन्हें सेना मुख्यालय से कई उल्लेख-इन-डिस्पैच और प्रशंसा मिली।भारत माता के महान सपूत मेजर सोमनाथ शर्मा ने महज 24 साल की उम्र में 3 नवंबर 1947 को शहादत प्राप्त की थी। मेजर सोमनाथ शर्मा देश के सबसे प्रतिष्ठित वीरता पुरस्कार के पहले प्राप्तकर्ता थे, और उन्होंने जो मिसाल कायम की, वह अभी भी सेना के भीतर लोकप्रिय है।
