RECRUITMENT NOTICE

Sub:- Advertisement for Engaging Teachers on Contract Basis, in AEC Schools, Jaduguda Centre for the Academic year 2026-2027.

It is proposed to conduct a skill test and Practical classroom observation (or a Demo Teaching Class) for engaging teachers on contract basis against the leave/regular vacancies that may arise during the academic year 2026-2027. The details of the post, pay, eligibility criterion and minimum and maximum age limits are given below.

Mode of Selection

- (a) A skill test and Practical classroom observation (or a Demo Teaching Class) will be conducted and the selected candidates will be empanelled and recruited in the order of merit.
- (b) Performance of the candidates will be assessed based on presentation by the candidates on two topics, one chosen by self and other provided by the school followed by personnel interaction on the subject

Qualifications:

- The candidates without CTET qualification can also apply against TGT.
- In case of PGTs, the candidates without B.Ed, but having 60% and above marks in case of Science subjects; and 55% marks in case of Humanities and Commerce in Post Graduation can be considered.
- In case of TGTs the candidates without B.Ed., but having 60% and above marks in case of Science subjects; and 55% marks in case of Humanities in Graduation can be considered.
- Graduates can be considered for the post of PRTs if candidates with +2 with D.Ed., are not available.
- Following panels of contract teachers will be prepared in the following manner.
 - Panel – 1 : Candidates with all the requisite qualifications for PGTs, TGTs, PRTs and Balvatika teachers.
 - Panel – 2 : Candidates without CTET for TGTs and PRTs separately.
 - Panel – 3 : Candidates without teaching qualification for PGTs, TGTs, PRTs and Balvatika separately.
- The panels mentioned above will be operated in sequential order viz. in the order of their merit and based on availability of vacancies at Jaduguda centre.
- The validity of the panel will be only for one year i.e. from 1st April to 31st March.
- In all the cases, the tenure of teachers appointed on contract basis shall be for one year or till the joining of regular incumbent whichever is earlier. The contract of the teacher will be terminated at the beginning of the vacation and breaks and they will

be reappointed after the vacation and breaks as per requirement.
