## **RECRUITMENT NOTICE**

### **Sub:- Engaging Teachers on Contract Basis, in AEC Schools, Jaduguda Centre for the Academic year 2025-2026–Third spell for TGT posts**

It is proposed to conduct skill test and a Demo Teaching Class for engaging teachers on contract basis against the leave/regular vacancies that may arise during the year 2025-2026 ( third spell) for the following teaching posts.

### **Teaching Posts**

#### **Details of Posts, Pay and Upper Age limit**

#### **Age Relaxation (Relaxation in upper age up to maximum of)**

Note: All the age relaxations mentioned above will be concurrent, i.e., if a person is eligible for more than one concession, only one of the concessions of the highest permissible limit will be granted.

### **Selection Process :**

- Contract teachers will be empanelled by conduct of skill test and a Demo Teaching class. Candidate need to prepare one topic of his choice to teach and another topic is to be picked by him at the time of demo test to deliver.
- Candidates up to age of 65 years can be allowed to apply irrespective of the period having worked in KVS, NVS or AEES.

### **Qualifications:**

- The candidates without CTET qualification can also apply against TGT.
- In case of TGTs the candidates without B.Ed., but having 60% and above marks in case of Science subjects; and 55% marks in case of Humanities in Graduation can be considered for Panel-3
- Following panels of contract teachers will be prepared in the following manner.
  - Panel – 1 : Requisite qualification.
  - Panel – 2 : Candidates without CTET for TGTs.
  - Panel – 3 : Candidates without teaching qualification for TGTs.
- The panels mentioned above will be operated in sequential order viz. in the order of their merit and based on availability of vacancies at Jaduguda centre.
- The validity of the panel will be only for one year i.e. from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 31<sup>st</sup> March.
- In all the cases, the tenure of teachers appointed on contract basis shall be for one year or till the joining of regular incumbent whichever is earlier. The contract of the teacher will be terminated at the beginning of the vacation and breaks and they will be reappointed after the vacation and breaks as per requirement.

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### **MODE OF SELECTION**

Skill test & Practical classroom observation – The candidates who will full fill the criteria for the post they have applied will be empanelled on the basis of their skill test and a Demo Teaching Class and will be operated as per the arising temporary vacancies in AEC Schools at Jaduguda centre. The panel will be valid for one year only i.e from 1-4-25 to 31-3-26.

4. As per AEES directive, the skill test will be based on 1 topic of own choice and one topic will be given on the spot.
5. No TA/DA is admissible for attending the skill test & demo class.
6. Canvassing in any form will lead to disqualification of candidature.
7. Candidates must bring all the original documents for verification.
